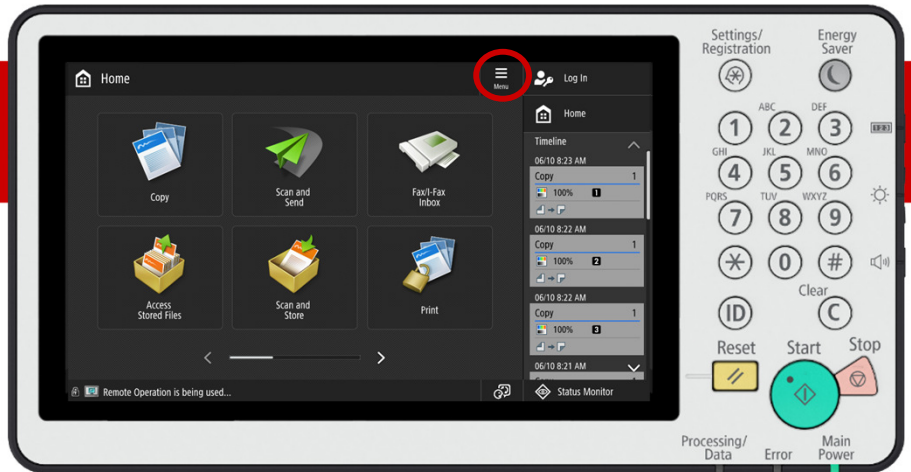

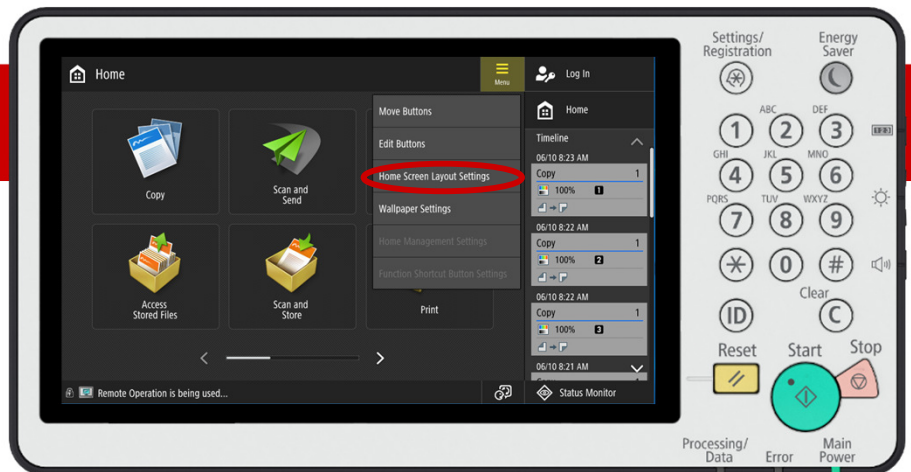
HOW TO:

Customizing the Home Screen – Change the Button Layout

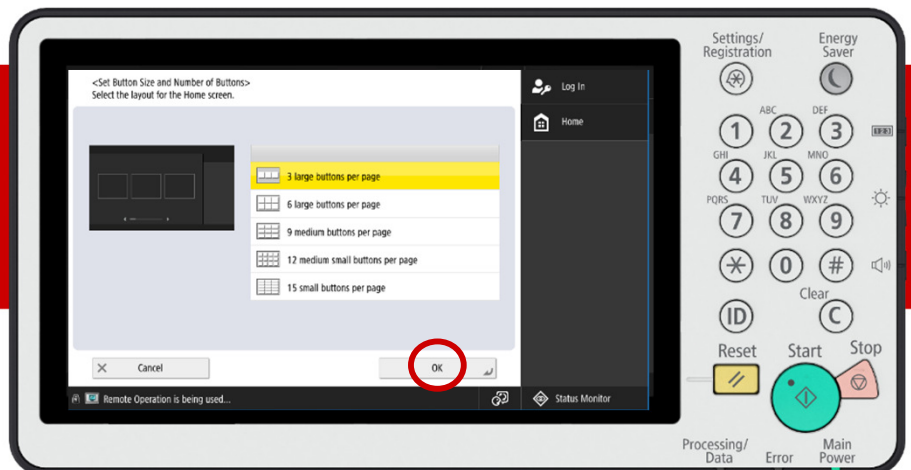
1 From the [Home Screen], select the [Menu] button



2 Select [Home Screen Layout Settings]



3 Select a button layout. Users can choose between three and fifteen buttons. A preview will be shown on the left side of the screen. Press [OK] once the desired option is selected.

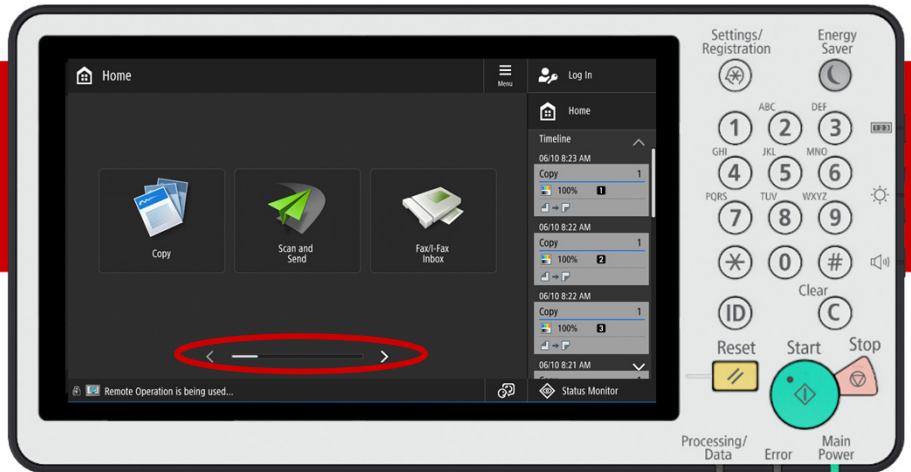

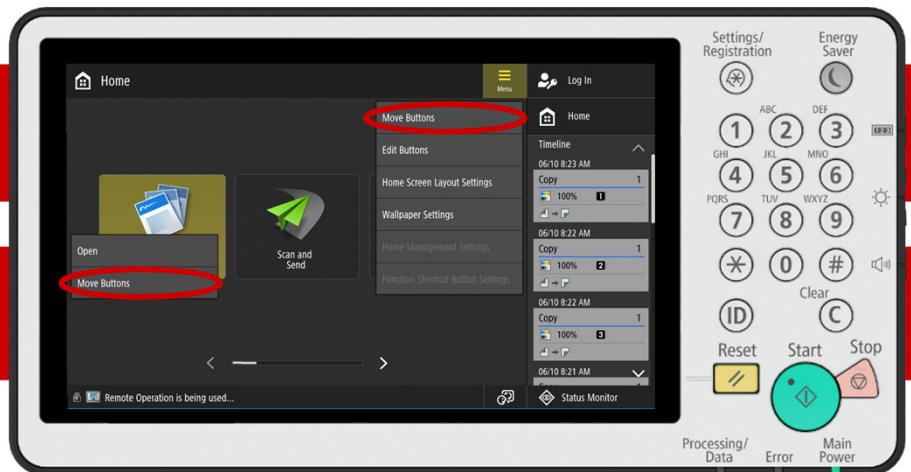

The Home Screen will now reflect the selected option for number of buttons on one page. Swipe or press the arrows to navigate through

To move buttons around, press the [Menu] button and select [Move Buttons]



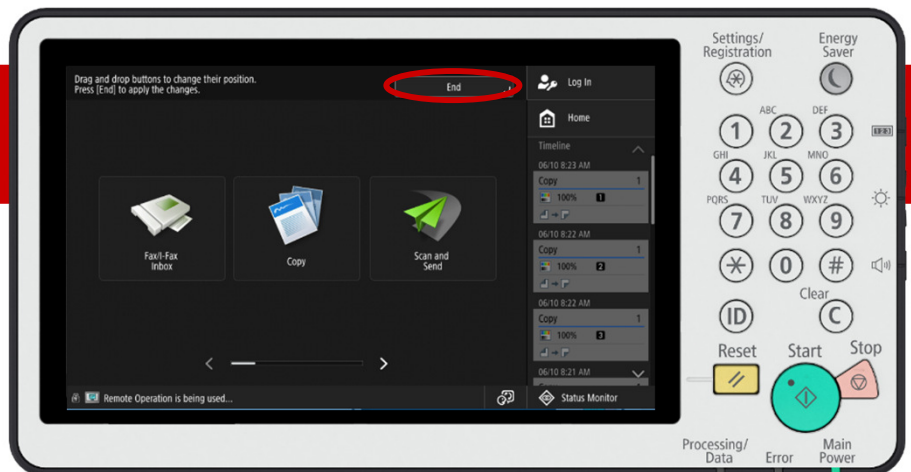

Alternatively, you can long press any button and a submenu will appear. Select [Move Buttons]

Drag and drop buttons to change their position. Once complete press [End]

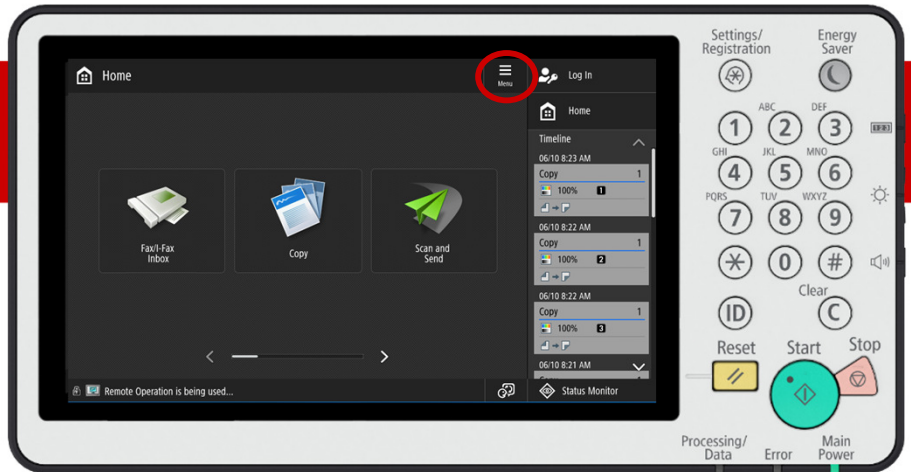
Note: Buttons can be moved to another page by dragging to the side of the screen. The page will automatically switch, and the button can then be placed in the preferred spot.



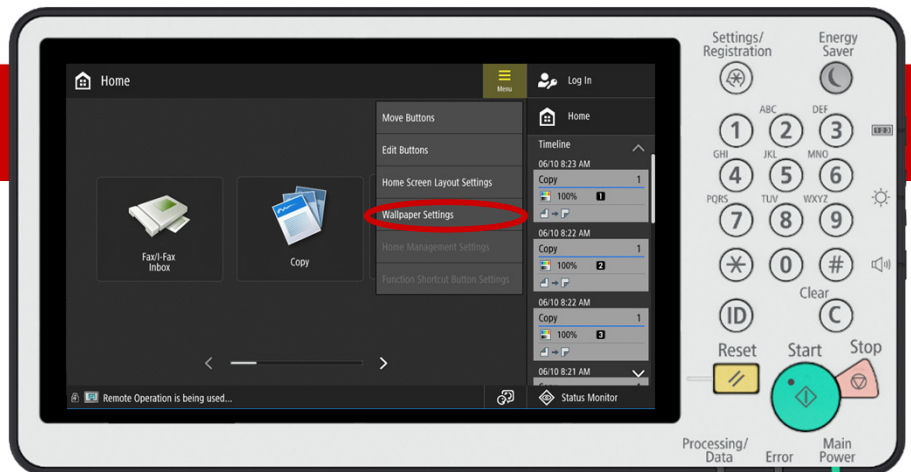

8 From the [Home Screen], select the [Menu] button

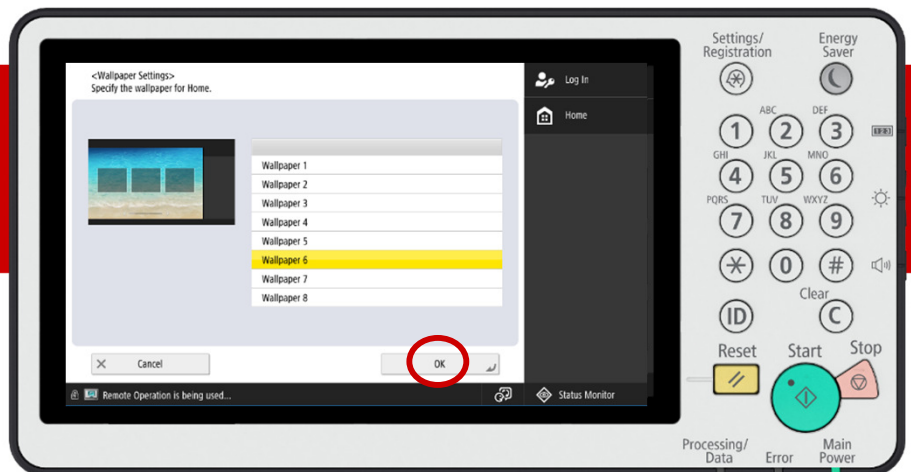


9 Select [Wallpaper Settings]

Note: You can also set a custom image such as a company photo or logo . This must be done through service mode.

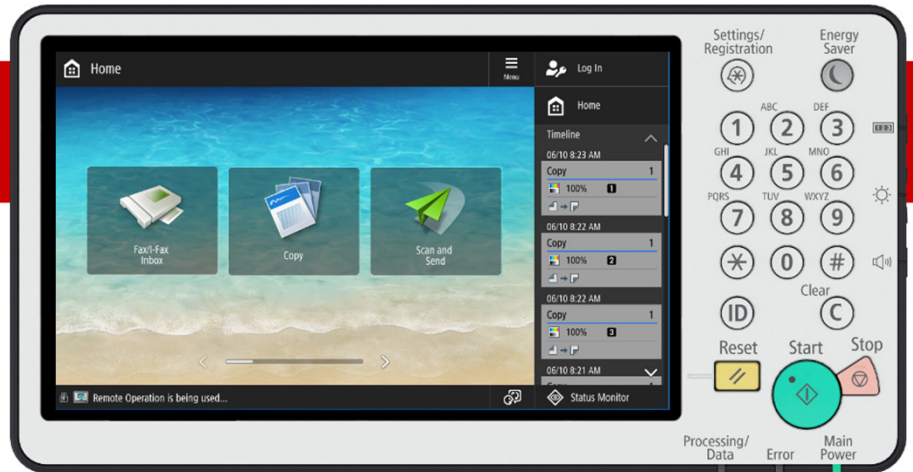
