


QUICK BUTTONS

SCENARIO

- Do you frequently use the same settings or functions on the device?
- Do you make a double sided copy with a staple for all of the invoices your business receives?
- Would you like to create a Quick Button that saves your settings for quick and easy use in the future?

BENEFITS

- Improve the workflow of many employees, as they can create a preset button with all of their commonly used settings
- Minimize the amount of touches on the screen, saving time and increasing ease of use
- With authentication, users can move their most used Quick Buttons to the front page for easy access

Quick Buttons – Creating a Quick Button

From the [Home Screen], select a function, such as [Copy]



Select the options that you would like to add in the Quick Button. For example, select [Finishing]

Note: Buttons may not be located in the same spot due to [Register Options Shortcuts]. Press [Options] for more settings.



Choose the desired finishing option, such as [Staple + Collate]. Press [Next] once complete





Quick Buttons – Creating a Quick Button

Select the type and position for stapling, then press [OK]



Select [2-Sided] to add double sided copying

Note: Buttons may not be located in the same spot due to [Register Options Shortcuts]. To find more settings, press [Options].

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Select the type for 2-Sided copying. Press [Set Details] for further settings. Press [OK] when complete





Quick Buttons – Creating a Quick Button

Returning to the main copy screen, press [Menu]



Select [Register to Home]



Confirm the settings that you would like to register in the Quick Button. Press [Next]





Quick Buttons – Creating a Quick Button

Enabling [Display Confirmation Screen When Recalling] means a screen will appear to confirm the settings. Enabling [Start Operation for Recall] will begin the job automatically when pressing [Start] on the Control Panel. Press [Next] when complete




Enter a name and comment, if necessary. Choose if the button is Personal or Shared. Press [OK]

Note: Buttons can only be registered as Personal if the device is configured with authentication, like ULM. Also, comments will not be displayed on 15 button layouts due to the size.

The new Quick Button is now located on the [Home Screen]. New buttons will always by default be located on the last

Note: The blue dot indicates a new button. After the first use, it will disappear. If Start Operation for Recall was turned On, there would also be an icon that looks like the [Start] button on the Control Panel








Quick Buttons – Moving a Quick Button

To move the button to a more convenient location on the screen, long press and select [Move Button]



Drag and drop the button to move its position. Once you are satisfied with its location, press



The Quick Button is now conveniently located based on user preference, for future use
